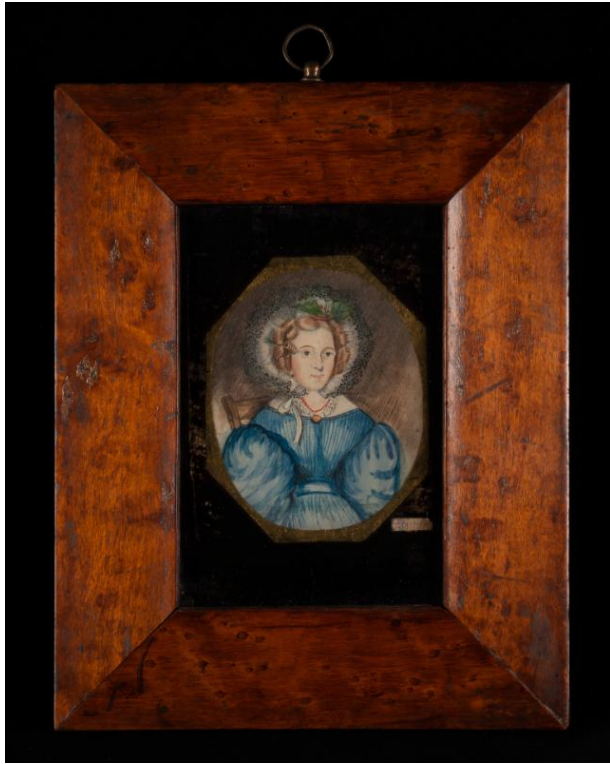


# Basic Detail Report

### Description
