Description

Figure of a man, seated. Figure is a white male. The figure's face is oval in shape. High forehead, hair is brushed forward at the temple and upwards at the top of the head. Figure has blue gray eyes, and a long, narrow, nose with a light hook at the end. Lips are narrow, with

the bottom lip being much fuller than the top. Proper left ear is visible. Figure wears a black double breasted coat, at has the up coat button fastened, and his hand tucked into the coat below this button. Shoulder of the coat are narrow and drop at a pronounced angle. Coat has a shawl collar with wide lapels especially near the collar. Sitter wears a white undershirt with a high starched collar, the three visible buttons of the shirt are open. Filling this open V provided by the shirt is a white, tall cravat or neck cloth. The neck cloth is ribbed and tucked many times and secured with a small bow at the direct center.
