

Description

Painting of the landscape of Mount Taurus (also known as Bull Hill) and the village at its foot, Cold Spring, in the Hudson Highlands. On the near bank, a couple sits under a dead tree while another man stands nearby; the ruins of Fort Putnam are to the right. The Hudson River is dotted with sailboats and schooners, while the far bank is covered with neatly delineated fields. A large church is the focal point of the village, with houses spaced out on either side below the mountain.
