Description

This scene shows a large raft being destroyed by a rock in a river, probably the Susquehanna, in a wooded area. Three men are aft, attempting to turn the raft with the tiller; three more are involved with the actual breaking-up of the raft, while one man lies at the front, trying to hold the paddle.
