**Description**

The scene depicted is set after Moses and the Jews crossed the Red Sea; half of Pharaoh's soldiers have been caught in the waters with their horses. The left bank is grassy while the right bank is grey. While Moses is dressed in a robe and carrying a crook, the other Jews are in modern clothing. There are also several geese and a goat on the right bank, as well as two people in a cart drawn by a donkey and a boy riding another donkey. People walk off into the mountains in the upper right.
