Description

"St. George" with dragon; multicolored telephone wire wrapped armature nailed to a square plywood base with bevelled edges; knight (St. George) on horse holding a long pike or spear plunged into the head of lizard-like dragon; knight with black boots, green pants, grey breastplate with brown and grey belt and sash, brown and red cape, orange, red, and purple shield and sword, round, domed hat with blue band with a metal star on

front and a multicolored plume or tassel in the center; knight is holding a long black and red pike or spear, ends wrapped in black electrical tape; horse is standing on its back hind legs; horse decorated with blue and yellow fringed breast collar on front and sides, a bridle with a metal star on forehead, yellow and blue saddle blanket that extends over rump, and a purple and green saddle; on the ground below and to the side of the horse is a purple, green, and red lizard-like dragon; dragon has two inverted black cones with trim, one on either side; the dragon has a spiked ridge line on center of head and neck; open mouth with red, forked tongue;
