Standing carved wooden piece painted white, red, and gold. Top section is a sunburst design incorporating such patriotic/militaristic symbols as cannon, rifles, anchors and swords. Below that a lyre shaped piece supports a stylized star. The base is composed of carved cross pieces placed at right angles to each other. The overall appearance is one of patriotic symbols combined in a fanciful fashion.
