Description

Hand carved peacock. Head and neck carved separately and glued to body. Wings again carved separately as is round tail and glued to body. Legs glued into holes in base of body and then into "snowshoe" shaped base. 1/8" hole in base of body, another hole through base behind legs and another hole front center of base. 2 nails hold legs to base. Beak is handcarved and glued. Black beads used for eyes. Colors: green, wing and base; body is dark blue and tail is green and yellow with red dabs. Tail has scalloped edge. "3" small nail hole design in base
