Description

Green painted wood box truck with open top and hinged ramp on the back. Wooden painted wheels, black for tire and painted red and black for the rim; there is a single set of wheels on each side at the front, and a double wheel set up on each side of the rear. Truck cab is an International truck style, the windows are painted white and outlined in black. The side windows are a two part window signifying a roll down window and a flip-window. Driver's side and passenger side on the box, painted in white: "HOWARD J. PETERS /ONEONTA, N.Y./LIVESTOCK & MACHINERY/WOOD, HAY, STRAW/TRUCKING & TRACTOR WORK/PH. 110J2 /634W3." Painted in white on the Front of cab on roof: "No. 3." On side of fender, both passenger and driver's side possibly scrawled while white background paint was still wet: "INTERNATIONAL/3(?)00." Painted on the unfinished underside of the truck in blue paint: "1950-19/INTERNATIONAL." Wooden nails hold the box sides to vertical supports. The hinge is created using a metal hook and wire set up with a hook and latch holding the ramp up into the box. Though truck is painted, the overall appearance of the wood is unfinished and rough, especially on exposed edges of the box and underside of the body.
