Description

Team of horses pulling a ground roller, made August 1997. Wooden sculpture of two horses pulling a ground roller and driver. Entire sculpture is made of pine; man's face, clothing, horses' tails, manes, and faces are drawn on the wood in pencil. The driver sits on a copper seat. Leather strips were cut to make the harness and reins. It is held together with small iron nails, screws, and brass pins. The ground roller does roll as the sculpture is moved.
