



## Boat and Water-skier Whirligig

Wood, metal, paint and plastic

### Description

Whirligig has shellacked pine wood blade that is pieced together with glued mortise joints - diagonal cuts across the central cube. There is metal joining that makes the whirligig function. The water-skier 's skin is painted a peach color and the bathing suit of the skier is green paint. There is a red boat with white trim; windshield in boat is made of plastic. The driver of the boat is a half-man figure, a head and upper chest. The metal joining mimicks the up and down motion of the water-skier.
