## Three Birds

### Date

Limestone

### Description

"Three birds" perched on base, equidistant. Birds are simply design, lines inscribed for wings and feet, small indentations for eyes. Stone itself gives texture rather than elaborate carving. Grain in stone follows angle of birds' bodies. Tails are squared off. Carved from one piece of stone.

### Dimensions

Overall: 7 1/4 × 11 1/2 × 10 1/2 in., 21 lb. (18.4 × 29.2 × 26.7 cm, 9.5 kg)
