### Description

Wooden polychrome figure of a standing woman. Figure facing forward, with light colored hair, wearing red liberty cap, and white full-length classical robes, draped with blue mantel. The right arm is held down, the hand resting on a shield with a blue field of 32 gold stars, above 7 white and 6 red vertical stripes. The left arm is raised to breast height, with the hand palm up, holding a golden

ball. To the left rear of the figure is a sheaf of wheat, gold. The figure, shield and wheat rest on a wooden base, painted blue. The base curves to a scroll top in front, and has two parallel supports extending from the bottom of the front. Gold foliated stalks are painted on the sides of each scroll and in the center of the front.
