Description

The gravestone lamb lies in a sleeping position with its body curved toward the right and only its tail and right front and back legs visible. Holes have been carved to give the appearance of fleece; however, its face is smooth except for the articulations of nostrils, eyes and mouth. Small pieces of green felt have been adhered to the flat bottom of the lamb, where there are brown marks, possibly from other adhesives, and a hole for support purposes.
