A pipe bowl made of black stone featuring a seated man with a book, “DB/Ch” is engraved on the right leaf of the book. The bowl is rectangular and widens at the top, the man sits cross-legged on the pipe with his back to the bowl. The man has a prominent nose, a narrow chin, and slits are carved into the stone for eyes.
