Description

Comb of moose or elk antler, at the center front near base of carving there is a pattern of finely incised lines forming a series of nested V shapes, measuring 5/8"; on reverse, in black ink: "326" "C124". Two dogs stand neck to neck and are looking in opposite directions. Their tails are long and reach the ground, they are in profile and only two legs are shown. They do not have defining features like

eyes, ears, noses, or mouths. The comb has 19 teeth.
