Description

Belt of silver, leather, metal, and thread, there is a rectangular remnant of an old adhesive label under the belt buckle. There are 7 pieces of silver that line a leather belt with a smaller circle of silver over the buckle. Each of the 7 silver circles has decorative edges with small holes poked all the way through as a part of the decoration. In the center a sideways diamond loop keeps the silver on the belt. concha
