Description

Moccasins of native tanned hide, dyed moose hair, cotton

binding and inside, loose heavy stock label with hand drawn red border label in black ink: "North American Indians Shoes Presd. by Mr. G. Moore" and on reverse, the same in pencil. The moccasins are hide except for the top of the toe area which has moose hair tufting floral designs. There is a hide bow beneath the designs, and then around the opening of the shoe is a downturned flap. The flap is edged with cotton and decorated with moose hair flowers in red, white, and blue.
