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## Moccasin

### Medium

Dyed hide, moosehair, cotton thread, silk lining, binding and ribbon

### Description

Moccasins of dyed hide, moose hair, cotton thread, silk lining, binding and ribbon. The moccasins are very narrow and have black hide. The top of the foot has intricate floral designs in blue, green, yellow, red, and white. There is a red bow beneath the designs and there is a flap around the rest of the moccasin. The flap is edged in red with more floral designs in blue, red, yellow, orange, green, and white. Areas without stitching are black.
