### Description

Ball-headed club of wood and on the bottom, in black ink: "156.104."; on side, in black ink: "2645". The handle end comes to a gentle point and there is a hole in the wood about two inches up from the bottom of the club. The handle continues, widening as it comes to the top. There is another hole about halfway up the handle. Where the handle starts to bend, there is an arrow-esque shaped carved through the handle. The ball-head has scalloped edges with holes carved through. The scalloped edges continue the entire way around the head of the club.
