The painting on the crown of this hat represents a highly abstract image of a whale. Women often created subtle surface patterns in their weaving and this hat has an understated pattern of diagonal parallel lines on its brim. Hats were respected clan heirlooms and were bestowed with prestigious traditional names.
