Pomo women excelled in the creation of special occasion basketry as this large basketry tray attest to. The diagonally arrangement of the pattern is executed in redbud and small disk shaped clam shell beads further embellish the decoration on the tray. Pomo basket weavers often left the warp ends project over the weft twining as is evident on edge of this tray.
