

# Basic Detail Report

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## Hat

### Date

c. 1870

### Primary Maker

Tuscarora (Haudenosaunee)

### Medium

Tradecloth, glass beads, thread, paillettes

### Description

Six triangular shaped panels, alternating red and black velvets comprise the construction of the hat. A 1 3/4" band of dark velvet materials form the bottom edge of hat. Each panel has a different floral/leaf design done in many different colored seed beads with a few sequins on five of the panels. The band around edge has a continuing line of arrow design in green beads. At top of hat and at one point on band are remnants of a ribbon decoration. Lining is four panels of a cotton material. Quite heavy from all the beadwork.

### Dimensions
