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## Leggings

### Date

Lakota (Teton Sioux)

### Medium

Hide, glass and metal beads

### Description

Leggings of hide, glass and metal beads. Both leggings are made from a piece of hide rolled to form a cylinder. The ends are tied together with hide. Both leggings have a background of white beads with American flags in red and blue beads and the flags are connected by lines, the flags totaling at 32 flags between the two legs of the leggings. The cross in the center is blue with yellow bead dots. The bottom of the leggings has a border of green beads followed by a repeating pattern of three red vertical bead stripes spaced by sections of white beads.
