The bag is in a long piece of hide that ends in hide fringe. At the top of the bag is a border of white beads with red, yellow, blue, and green stripes. Continuing down the sides of the bag, the white beads remain but the stripes of colored beads become squares. On the body of the bad there are tassels that end in horsehair and tin cones. Beneath those are four triangles of beads in green and blue. There is a square of beadwork after the tassels. The background is white, there are two American flags, a blue church, and two green teepees. The square is bordered by blue and yellow beads. After the white square there are three inverted triangles in red, blue, and red. These also have bead tassels that end in tin cones. The rest of the
