Description

Cases of commercial leather, native tanned leather, glass beads, tin cones, brass beads, and German silver button.

Case A starts with two leather thongs, two beads beads, three white beads, and two brass beads and is followed by a square of beads in white, blue, and red. Edging that is leather fringe with tin cones and four longer tassels

ending in silver. The next section is a rectangle with more white, red, and blue beads. This is also edged with leather tassels and tin cones with four longer tassels with silver on the end. Case B starts with leather thongs with two brass beads, three white beads, two brass beads and leads into the semi-circle opening flap of the case. The case closes with a brass button in the center. The leather opening flap is decorated with red, white, and blue beads and edged with leather fringe and tin cones. The body of the bad is decorated with red, white, blue, and black beads. The background is red, and the abstract design is white, blue, and black. The bag ends with leather fringe and tin cones and four longer tassels ending in silver. Case C starts with leather thongs with two brass beads, three white beads, two brass beads and leads into a square covered in red beads with a blue and white design. That is edged by leather fringe with tin cones and four longer tassels ending in silver. The body of the bag is triangular in shape, has a red bead background with white and blue designs. The bag ends with tin cones attached with leather and three longer tassels.
