Knife and Sheath

Date

c. 1830

Primary Maker

Anishinaabe (Red River Ojibwa)

Medium

Knife: steel, African buffalo horn, brass and bone fittings,
Sheath: hide, porcupine quills, sinew

Description

The steel knife is oblong with the end sharpening to a point. The handle is also rounded with five screws total holding it together. The top of the handle has a circle with a white and red center. The sheath is multi-colored dyed porcupine quills in a geometric pattern

Dimensions

Overall (Sheath): $14 \times 4 \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{3}{4}$ in. (35.6 x 11.4 x 1.9 cm) Overall (Knife): $14 \times 2 \frac{3}{4} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. (35.6 x 7 x 1.3 cm)
