

# **Description**

The two painted carvings on this wand likely represent moths. They have the heavy bodies of moths and the long projections from the ends of the wings strongly suggest Luna moths. Butterfly and moth symbolism are generally associated with fertility and are sometimes painted on pottery and embroidered on ceremonial mantas and sashes.
