Nuu-chah-nulth (Nootka)

### Medium

Spruce, small mammal teeth or shell

### Description

This subtly modeled comb represents a spirit or human. It is a work of great artistry, illustrating the masterful handling of sensitively carved facial features that slightly differ on each side. The inward-curling upper corners of the comb seem to suggest whales rising out of the water.
