This small mask needed an additional reed hoop, a pair of ochre-stained thumbless spirit hands and a double row of

snowy owl feathers. The thumbless hands refer to the inability of the spirits to grasp and catch game animals thereby ensuring the availability of the hunt for the Central Yup'ik.
