Wood (probably spruce), copper, opercula, human hair, twine, paint, leather

Description
This carved helmet is a classic of the war helmet tradition, masterfully incorporating a red-breasted merganser bird into the helmet's functional design. The pegged-in human hair extends and exaggerates the bird's crest, lending a sense of animation to the helmet. War helmets are unique to Tlingit traditional culture. The imagery on each helmet

is distinct.
