Description

This Tlingit mask represents a woman wearing a labret, or lip ornament, in her lower lip. When a girl reached puberty her lower lip was pierced and a labret was inserted. The large size of this labret is a sign of her high rank.

Decorative changes to the face and body had deep spiritual associations relating to identity, status and age and were part of a larger ritual expression relating to dress and public presentation. Tattooing and piercing were eternal statements of belief and identity.
