## Food Tray

### Description

Elongated feast trays are prominently displayed at feasts. The identity of the abstracted face on this tray is not known, but it has powerful symbolic references to wealth and abundance. The edges of the tray mimic the outline of a copper, an object associated with a chiefly status and affluence.
