## Description

These combs pay homage to the artist's Haudenosaunee (Iroquois) ancestors, who made similar carvings until the late 1700s. The artist, a steel worker for most of his life, began to carve at the age of 55, and his award-winning work has had a great impact on other contemporary Native carvers.
