Description

Anasazi potters invented and perfected vessels that were painted ivory to golden ochre tones and detailed with brilliant pigments. These three vessels illustrate the pinnacle of this artistic tradition known as Sikyatki Polychrome (1375-1625). The perfection of form and the incorporation of numerous colors date these vessels to between 1450-1500. The appearance of kachina imagery, benevolent spirit beings, within the interior of the bowls also points to this time period.
