## Description

Pencil on paper sketch showing a man leaning on his rifle with a building in the right background. Man is wearing what appears to be a one-piece outfit and stockings. Some objects are sketched below the man, but are not identifiable. In the man's belt sites a knife. To the bottom left is "D" for the artist's signature. Below the boxed out image is "Leatherstocking." On the reverse side of the

paper are two additional sketches. The first shows a man wearing a colonial-like outfit holding the hand of a young girl. This image has been cut as only half of the man is showing. The second image shows two men in a canoe with paddles. This image is also boxed out and shows a rock in the background along with some foliage. Men wear leather-like outfits and caps. To the bottom left of this image within the box is "Darley" and below the box to the right, barely legible reads "Appleton's Ediction 1872."
