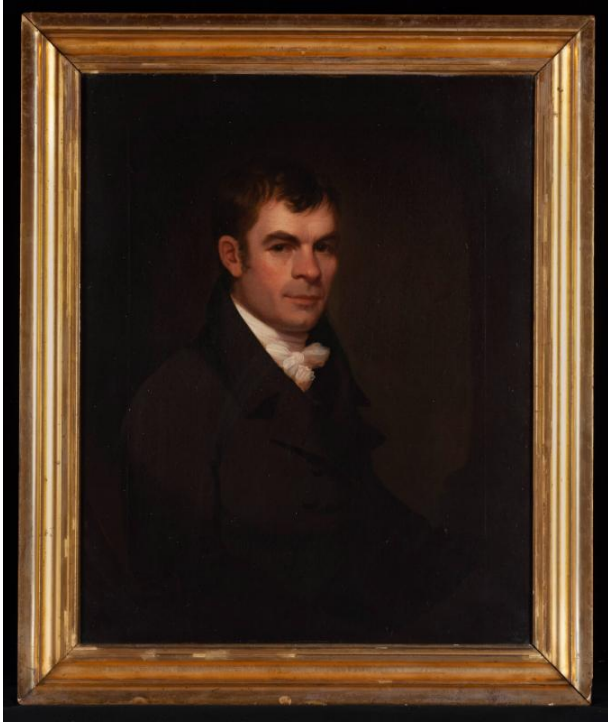

Admitted to N.Y./ bar, practiced law; apptd. 1st judge of Jefferson/County (N.Y.), 1785, again apptd, 1810; moved/to Cooperstown, N.Y.; mem. N.Y. Senate, (1799-/1803; N.Y. Assembly, 1807, 10; mem. U.S. Ho./of Reps. (Federalist) from N.Y., 13th-14th con-/gresses, 1813-17; resumed law practice. Died Platts-/burg, N. Y., May 30, 1838; buried Riverside Ceme-/tary, Plattsburg."
