## Winter Skating Scene

### Date

Late 19th century

### Primary Maker

### Medium

Oil on stained glass

### Description

A framed, oil painted stained glass ice skating scene. Regarding the surface paint, a layer of black paint was used to cover all of the glass, then scraped away to get the background. The surface was painted with oil paint (not reverse painting, not vitreous enamel). There is no glaze over the paint. The glass was cut into pieces (like a jigsaw puzzle), glazed together, and soldered at the joints and around the entire outer edge to the frame with lead cane. The glass pieces that are glazed together and soldered together at the joints are sandwiched between a wooden frame and a single piece of glass (used as backing). Miniature
