white silk ribbon bow at the bottom. A light blue shawl patterned with green and orange botehs is draped over her shoulders. Her hair, frizzed around her head and rolled into large curls at ear level, is powdered and covered with a ruffled cap, trimmed with another white satin ribbon. A thinner ribbon is tied around her neck.
