Description

Navajo Flag Rug - Laverne Barber; 50 star American flag. Seven red (3 3/4" wide) and six white (3 1/2" wide) alternating strips. Four stripes each 55 1/2" long and four stripes (90" long). Blue field (34" long x 25 1/2" high) in upper left corner contains 50 five pointed stars. All four sides hemmed and all four corners tied off. Ends are woven in three or four warp/wefts and then bound off. Woven as a tribute to an uncle who served in the Vietnam War.
