## Face Jug

Stoneware with kaolin and maganese glaze

### Description

Head-shaped jug, glazed with black manganese, with stereotypical Black features. Incised eyebrows and facial hair, thick teeth made with kaolin clay; protruding eyes, nose, and ears (though proper left ear is broken off). Cork is in neck, which is at the crown of the head.
