## Description

Silver chain fastening at back of neck with simple hook, consisting of .25" spherical beads. Beads run in one strand for 2.5" from hook, then split to two; after 2.5" of separate double strands the two are connected with long silver floral beads every two spheres. Pendant is made in the shape of a thin crescent, with a roughly rectangular piece of turquoise hanging from center. Navajo/Diné.
