## Description

Handmade wood pulp paper book with pressed, colored and banded decoration throughout. The book, if opened entirely flat, would appear as a wampum belt. The front cover has three paper bands which wrap into and around the spine of the book to keep it together. There is a pressed image of an over-sized Indian-coin that reads "United States Of America/1877." On the back cover there is an additional, but different, pressed image of an oversized Indian coin that reads "Liberty/1914." There are three additional paper bands wrapping into and around

the spine of the book to hold it together. The wampum belt is differentiated by a band of pink running through the center of each of the inside pages. Set into this band are images laid in black ink to represent the figures seen on a wampum belt. On the last page in the bottom right corner the artist has signed the book "Roger Parish/12/95."
