Ear handled jug with incised cobalt design of stem with two large and two small leaves, and draping flower. Same design appears on front and back below kiln and makers name. Splotches of blue appear where handles were

applied; lower part of each handle is marked with a blue "x" over portion attached to jug. Two splotches of blue outside of flower design on reverse. Cylindrical metal band around lip of jug. In cobalt blue around rim: "COERLEARS HOOK". In cobalt blue on back: "N. YORK". On the bottom are 3 white labels: one is marked "#7" another is marked "box/#7" and the third is marked "SWINNEY/STRONG". Grey glaze.
