



## Knife sheath

### Medium

Hide, porcupine quills

### Description

Menominee Quilled Knife Sheath; Leather quill knife sheath. Quills dyed reddish/brown, brown, beige. Top edge quill work runs up sides and around points at top. Across top of pouch quill pattern overlapping 2 rows. Triangles and circles, with leaf pattern design next to continuous pattern runs full length from opening, lines plus

zigzag quills run along edge. Leather piece attached top left. Back two pieces of leather hand sewn.

### Dimensions
