Description

In this self-portrait, Han depicts himself seated while painting on a large, wheeled easel. He wears jeans and sandals. A small, red square carpet lies beneath his chair and a jar of paintbrushes behind him. A large wheeled mirror stands off to the side, reflecting the back of the easel. A rectangular green ottoman sits in the foreground, with what appears to be Han's discarded white shirt lain across it. A window in the background illuminates the artist's studio. Through the window, a building with numerous windows is visible. The back of the frame is stamped "Babcock Galleries."
