## Description

This figure is made of wood, feather, and pigments, on the reverse, in black ink: "t 6.10/985"; circular label in black mechanical ink: "59"; adhesive marks of rectangular label. The face of the doll has a prominent, angular nose with red pigment on the nose, black pigment on the forehead, and a reddish brown on the cheeks and chin. The shoulders are broad and there is a small amount of red pigment on the collarbone. It appears as if black pigment has faded from the shoulders. The torso has a rectangular cutout and the arms lead directly into the hips (there are no hands). The legs have identifiable kneecaps and no feet. The doll has a roach spreader and a black and white feather.
