Cribbing the Corn

Description

A Triple Box Wagon filled with corn, and a portable derrick

used to pull the elevator up to the crib's cupola (the wheels put the "portable" in the portable elevator) A two-horse, triple gear "Outfit" powered the chain driven elevator. An overhead lifting jack, also powered by the horse, tipped the wagon so its load of ear corn could tumble into the elevator's trough.
