Description

Silo 76: Monolithic Concrete, 28' x 14', c. 1948, not currently in use. Has unique oval doors, built by Canadians, they would jump down from the top into a pile of sand as they built it up. Grandfather bought the farm as 28 acres in 1934, son took it over in 1985, then current owner in 1992. Farm is 28 tillable acres, with 19 cows, 10 heifers. The silo never had an unloader in it, which was a smart decision because it saved a lot of money and for the size they were it wouldn't have been worth it,
