Description

Wood building with a stone foundation. On the end are two high windows, a window on the ground floor and a door. A landing off the door has a bicycle leaning against

it. On the facing side is one window, and three doorways. In the first doorway a man stands leaning against the door jam, wearing a dark suit and hat. Next to him sits a bag of feed. Above the door is a sign that says D.F. Talbot & Sons In the next doorway stands two men one wears darks pants, jacket and hat. The other a dark jacket and light hat. He holds a feed bag. In the third door stands a man in overalls. In front of the door is a wagon hitched to two horses. A man stands in the back of the wagon. Light colored bags can be seen in the back of the wagon. A bicycle can be seen leaning against a pole to the right of the building.
